IASSS WORKSHOP

NON-TECHNICAL SKILLS FOR SURGEONS (NOTSS)

This one-day course is for surgical trainees & surgeons to learn about the concept of non-technical skills in surgery. The non-technical skills which underpin safer operative surgery will be examined in detail with short talks, video simulated scenarios and small group discussions.

By the end of this masterclass, participants should be able to:

- 1. Discuss the underlying principles of non-technical skills which contribute to safe surgical care.
- 2. Differentiate between four major categories of non-technical skills: Situation Awareness, Decision Making, Team Communication, and Leadership.
- 3. Identify and assess surgical non-technical skills in a series of operative video simulations using the NOTSS taxonomy.
